1 Introduction

1.1 Scope and Applicability

This document details Supplemental Terms and Conditions, that it may be necessary to issue for a particular fair, these need to read with the main Terms and Conditions document, both documents collectively form the Terms and Conditions.

These apply to everyone who has a stall, provides entertainment or provides a service to the Downton Cuckoo Fair ie all contractors, stallholders, entertainers, produce market, fairground operators, caterers and other participants, hereafter referred to as ‘merchants’.

2 SUPPLEMENTAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

2.1 Applications

If you are applying for more than one type of stall please complete one booking form per stall. For example, Merchants wishing to apply for example, one food and one fairground, will need to complete two different forms.

2.2 Fair Site Opening Hours / Overnight Arrangements

The Cuckoo Fair is held in the middle of the Downton village. As such we request that all our merchants ensure that they observe the curfew that runs from 2200 hrs Friday night to 0600hrs Saturday morning. During this time there is to be no activity on site.

2.3 COVID Precautions

In 2022 it is expected that the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic will be lessening however the Cuckoo Fair is held in the middle of the Downton village and results in a significant increase in the population of the village, approximately increasing it ten-fold. To mitigate this increase in population we require that our Merchants apply the following COVID mitigations as a minimum:

- All stalls to have hand sanitiser available (at least 60% alcohol).
- Strongly advise mask wearing
- Strongly Advise Lateral Flow Test prior to attending fair and only attend if it is negative.
- Ask anyone experiencing Covid symptoms to not attend the fair.
- Advise any stall offering samples (food & drink) to mandate hand sanitiser prior to trying.
- Advise any stall offering samples to utilise PPE (gloves) to dispose of any waste, ensuring waste is disposed of immediately.
- For those merchants with items/surfaces that are frequently touched or handled (eg counter-tops or fairground rides etc) it is strongly recommend that they are wiped down frequently to a defined rota of *cleaning*

2.4 Memorial Gardens / Rural Crafts / Fairground area – NEW LAYOUT

2.5 Caterers Reminder Pre-Packaged Food for Direct Sales (PPDS)

As a reminder, please note, the law on Allergens changed in October 2021. All Pre-Packaged Food for Direct Sales (PPDS) will need to carry allergen advice in the same way as packaged food is currently required to do. 2.6 Stop Notices

Any merchant found in breach of the DCFC Ts & Cs for whatever reason may be issued with a stop notice and required to cease trading / operating. Note the merchant cannot move their vehicle(s) until the end of the Fair. They may however, pack away their produce ready for the end of the Fair. Also, may carry the stall and its contents to their vehicle.
